7. Dogs on 6 foot leash at all times

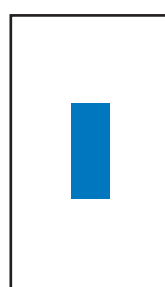
**Activities Not Allowed:**

7. Mountain Biking

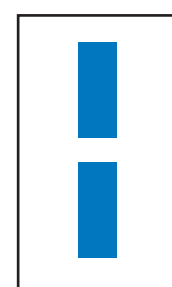

The colored trail blazes used on these trails follow the standard arrangements used by the CT Forest and Park Association:

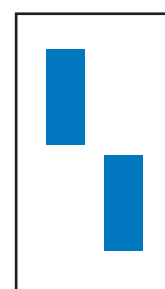
Continue in same direction:



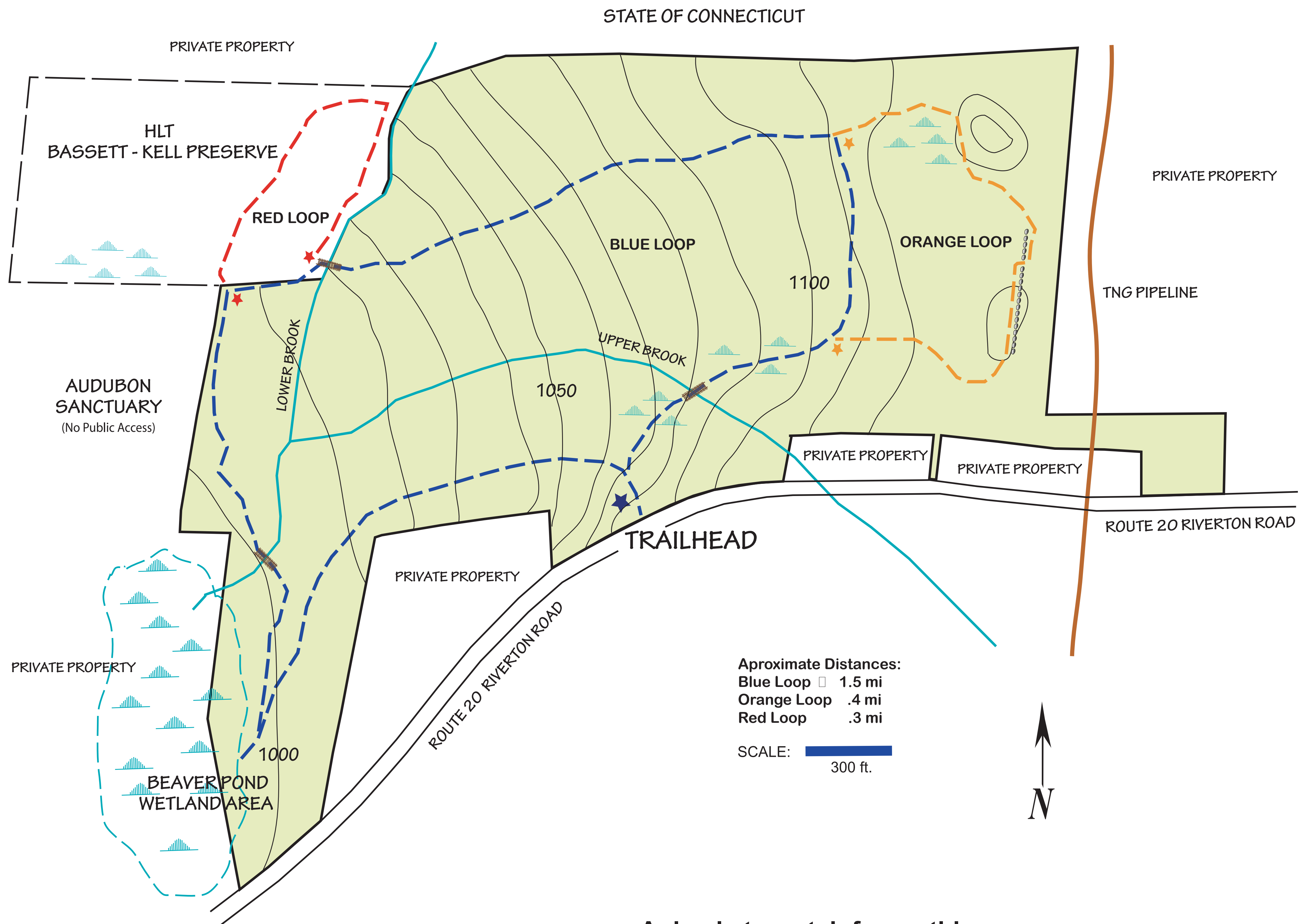
End of Trail:
