Hike with NHLT and OSPC members through two Town preserves: the 118-acre Goula Open Space Preserve and the 59-acre section of Phillips Farm that are protected in perpetuity. Starting near the highest point in Town on Cotton Hill, this trek will wind through meadows, woodlands and working hayfields with long views to the east. Walkers will also pass a pristine, open-water wetland that connects the two Preserves. Both were conserved as open space and farmland through the Town of New Hartford's open space program with State of Connecticut Open Space grants and local taxpayer funds. The Trust for Public Land provided critical assistance as well. Bring your binoculars and cameras! Dogs must be leashed.
